Fund Benefits

- UHN provides a vehicle to hedge heating oil movements or to take directional positions on heating oil prices
- UHN offers the convenience of an exchange-traded security (NYSE Arca)
- UHN permits commodity-like exposure without using a commodity futures account
- UHN provides "equity-like" order flexibility, including market, limit, stop, stop limit and GTC orders
- UHN provides Market Price, NAV, and Portfolio Holdings on a daily basis

Investors may choose to use UHN as a means of investing indirectly in heating oil and there are risks involved in such investments. Among other things, the heating oil industry experiences numerous operating risks. The risks and hazards that are inherent in the heating oil industry may cause the price of heating oil to widely fluctuate. The exploration for, and production of, crude oil, the raw material used to produce heating oil, is an uncertain process with many risks. The cost of drilling, completing and operating wells for crude oil is often uncertain, and a number of factors can delay or prevent drilling operations or production.

Fund Description

The United States Heating Oil Fund, LP (UHN) is an exchange-traded security that is designed to track in percentage terms the movements of the price of heating oil delivered to the New York harbor (heating oil). UHN issues units that may be purchased and sold on the NYSE Arca.

- UHN's Objective** – The investment objective of UHN is for the changes in percentage terms of the units' net asset value to reflect the changes in percentage terms of the price of heating oil as measured by the futures contract on heating oil traded on the New York Mercantile Exchange that is the near month contract to expire, except when the near month contract is within two weeks of expiration, in which case it will invest in the next month to expire, less UHN's expenses.
- UHN's Target** – Heating oil is one of the most important physical commodities in the global economy. Heating oil futures are one of the most actively traded futures contracts and represent the primary US benchmark for heating oil prices.
- UHN's Portfolio** – The portfolio consists of listed heating oil futures contracts and other heating oil-related futures, forwards and swap contracts. These investments will be collateralized by cash, cash equivalents and US government obligations with remaining maturities of two years or less.

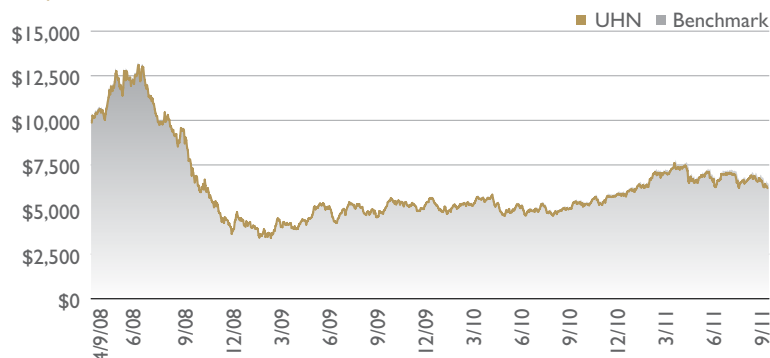

This chart shows how a hypothetical investment of \$10,000 in the Fund at its inception would have performed versus an investment in the Fund's benchmark index. UHN seeks to manage its portfolio such that the average daily changes in its Net Asset Value ("NAV") over any period of 30 successive valuation days is within 10%+/- of the average daily change in the price of the Benchmark Futures Contract(s). The Benchmark Futures Contract is the near month futures contract for heating oil delivered to the New York harbor. When the near month contract is within two weeks of expiration, the Benchmark Futures Contract will become the next month contract to expire.

An investment in the units issued by the United States Heating Oil Fund, LP (“UHN”), involves risk. These risks can significantly impact the market value of the units. Some of the risks you may face are summarized below. A more extensive discussion of these risks appears in the prospectus preceding or accompanying this brochure.

- Unlike mutual funds, commodity pools or other investment pools that actively manage their investments in an attempt to realize income and gains from their investing activities and distribute such income and gains to their investors. UHN generally does not distribute cash to limited partners or other unit holders. You should not invest in the UHN if you will need cash distributions from UHN to pay taxes on your share of income and gains of UHN, if any, or for any other reason.
- UHN will pay fees and expenses that are incurred regardless of whether they are profitable.
- You will have no rights to participate in the management of UHN and will have to rely on the duties and judgment of the General Partner to manage UHN.
- UHN seeks to have changes in its units’ NAV, in percentage terms, track changes in the price of heating oil, in percentage terms, rather than profit from speculative trading of heating oil interests. The General Partner will therefore endeavor to manage UHN’s positions in heating oil interests so that UHN’s assets are, unlike those of other commodity pools, not leveraged (i.e., so that the aggregate value of UHN’s unrealized losses from its investments in such heating oil interests at any time will not exceed the value of UHN’s assets). If the General Partner permits UHN to become leveraged, you could lose all or substantially all of your investment if UHN’s trading positions suddenly turn unprofitable.
- There is the risk that the changes in the price of UHN’s units on the NYSE Arca will not closely track the changes in the price of heating oil. If these correlations do not exist, then investors may not be able to use UHN as a cost-effective way to invest indirectly in heating oil or as a hedge against the risk of loss in heating oil-related transactions.
- Investors, including those who directly participate in the heating oil industry, may choose to use UHN as a vehicle to hedge against the risk of loss and there are risks involved in hedging activities. While hedging can provide protection against an adverse movement in market prices, it can also preclude a hedger’s opportunity to benefit from a favorable market movement.
- UHN invests primarily in heating oil futures contracts that are traded in the United States. However, a portion of UHN’s trades may take place in markets and on exchanges outside the United States. Some non-U.S. markets present risks because they are not subject to the same degree of regulation as their U.S. counterparts.
- UHN may also invest in other heating oil interests, many of which are negotiated contracts that are not as liquid as heating oil futures contracts and expose UHN to credit risk that its counterparty may not be able to satisfy its obligations to UHN.

Important Considerations

- **UHN is not mutual fund or any other type of Investment Company within the meaning of the Investment Company Act of 1940, as amended, and is not subject to regulation there under.**
- **Commodity prices and futures generally are volatile and are not suitable for all investors. UHN is speculative and involves a high degree of risk. An investor may lose all or substantially all of an investment in UHN. Funds that focus on a single sector generally experience greater volatility.**
- **Units of UHN may be purchased or sold throughout the day through any brokerage account, which will result in typical brokerage commissions. However, only authorized participants may create units directly from or redeem units directly to UHN, in large block creation/redemption baskets.**
